Waterfront Parking for Veterans

WHEREAS to improve enjoyment of the waterfront for Ajax residents, the Town offers an annual waterfront parking permit program from May to September;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Ajax has a proud military history, serving as the home of the largest shell filling plant in the British Commonwealth during World War II, was named in honour of the Royal Navy ship H.M.S. Ajax and has celebrated veterans who served aboard the ship by naming local streets in their honour;

AND WHEREAS Ajax desires to further honour veterans and their commitment and service to Canada.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. Vehicles with an Ontario Veteran graphic licence plate be permitted to park in designated parking areas at Rotary Park, Central Waterfront, and Paradise Beach without obtaining a resident waterfront parking permit beginning with the 2023 season; and
2. By-law Services staff bring forward an amending by-law to the May 15, 2023, Council meeting to implement the necessary changes; and
3. By-law Services and Communications staff update the information on the waterfront parking permit program information contained on the Town's website to communicate the change to the Ajax community.
