Municipal Asset Management Plan Grant Submission

WHEREAS Asset Management Planning (AMP) is an ongoing and long-term process that allows municipalities to make the best possible investment decisions for their infrastructure assets;

AND WHEREAS the Government of Ontario implemented the *Asset Management Planning for Municipal Infrastructure Regulation, O. Reg. 588/17 as amended by the O. Reg. 193/21*, which requires municipalities to have publicly posted and Council-approved comprehensive Municipal Asset Management Plan for both core and non-core infrastructure assets, including levels of service, activities and funding strategies, by July 1, 2025;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Ajax completed and approved its Asset Management Plan for all core assets prior to the provincial regulatory deadline of July 1, 2022;

AND WHEREAS staff have initiated the development of the Asset Management Plan for all non-core assets which must be approved by Council by July 1, 2024;

AND WHEREAS staff have obtained a quote from a consultant in line with the Town's Purchasing By-law and procedures for \$65,970 to complete the non-core asset management plan requirements;

AND WHEREAS the federal government has made grant funding available to municipalities for completing Asset Management Plans through the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) up to a maximum of \$50,000 per application.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED THAT:

1. Ajax Council directs staff to apply for a \$50,000 grant from the FCM's Municipal Asset Management Program for a portion of the work required to complete an Asset Management Plan;
2. A review of the current non-core Infrastructure State and a Level of Service review be completed as part of this project;
3. The balance of funding required to complete this portion of the project (approximately \$15,970) be funded from the Town's Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) Reserve.
