

9.4 Parking Relief for Overnight Medical Support

Whereas access to adequate overnight parking is a concern for residents who require ongoing medical support during late or overnight hours; and

Whereas caregivers and medical professionals often provide essential care outside of standard hours, which may result in parking infractions that create unnecessary hardship; and

Whereas other municipalities, including the City of Ottawa – which offers a Health Care Parking Permit – have explored or implemented parking relief measures in support of medical needs; and

Whereas a structured and equitable approach to parking relief could support the health and well-being of residents without compromising enforcement or operational goals;

Therefore Be It Resolved:

1. That Bylaw Services staff be directed to prepare a report for the November 10, 2025 General Government Committee meeting, outlining:
 - a) The viability and practicality of implementing parking relief for overnight medical support and stays in excess of three (3) hours;
 - b) A financial analysis of potential impacts;
 - c) Policy options for Council's consideration.
