

## **The Corporation of the Town of Ajax**

### **By-Law Number 126-2009**

A By-law to classify regulate and licence adult entertainment establishments

**Whereas** the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O 2001, authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws for licensing, regulating, governing, classifying and inspecting any business wholly or partly carried on within the municipality, including adult entertainment establishments;

**And whereas** the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O 2001, authorizes Council to pass by-laws, with respect to adult entertainment establishments, that limit the number of licences to be granted, define areas in which Adult Entertainment Establishments are permitted, and prohibit any person engaged in the business or any person under the age of 18 years to enter or remain in the establishment;

**And whereas** a public meeting was held in Council Chambers of the Town of Ajax to discuss the proposed by-law on November 16, 2009;

**Now therefore**, the Corporation of the Town of Ajax hereby enacts as follows:

#### **1. Short Title**

1.1 This By-law may be cited as the Adult Entertainment Establishment By-law.

#### **2. Definitions**

2.1 In this By-law:

- (a) "adult entertainment establishment" means any premises or part thereof in which, in the pursuance of a business, entertainment or Services designed to appeal to erotic or sexual appetites or inclinations, are provided or permitted, either alone or in conjunction with other services;
- (b) "attendant" means a person, and may include an owner or operator, who provides Services;
- (c) "Committee" means the Committee of Council to which Council has delegated the responsibility of handling licensing matters;
- (d) "Council" means the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Ajax;
- (e) "designed to appeal to erotic or sexual appetites or inclinations" includes any service of which a principal feature or characteristic is the nudity or partial nudity of any person; and any service in respect of which any one or more of the words "nude", "naked", "topless", "bottomless", "sexy", "table dancing", "lap dancing", "wet T-shirt" or any other word or picture, symbol, or representation having like meaning or implication is used directly or indirectly, is advertised or described as involving any such Services;
- (f) "fully clothed" means to be clothed in such a manner that the person's pubic area, genital area, breasts and chest are fully covered by opaque material;
- (g) "licence" means an authorization under this By-law to carry on the trade, calling, business or occupation specified therein;
- (h) "Licensing Officer" means a person appointed by the Town to issue licences, and includes a person appointed by Council for the express purpose of issuing licences under this By-law, and includes a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer;
- (i) "Medical Officer of Health" means the Medical Officer of Health for the Regional Municipality of Durham;

- (j) "Municipal Law Enforcement Officer" means a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer appointed to enforce the By-laws of the Town;
- (k) "Officer" means a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer appointed to enforce the By-laws of the Town;
- (l) "operator" means a person who, alone or with others, operates, manages, supervises, runs, directs or controls an adult entertainment establishment and shall be an individual and not a partnership or corporation;
- (m) "owner" means a person who, alone or with others, owns or controls the trade, calling, business or occupation carried on at an adult entertainment establishment or who directs the activities of an operator and "owner" includes a person who is the tenant or licensee in respect of premises which are utilized as an adult entertainment establishment;
- (n) "person" means a natural individual, and their heirs, executors, administrators or other legal representatives, a corporation, partnership or other form of business association or a receiver or mortgagee in possession;
- (o) "provide" when used in relation to Services at an adult entertainment establishment includes to furnish, perform, solicit, offer, or give such Services in pursuance of a trade, calling, business or occupation. The terms "provides", "providing" and "provision" have corresponding meanings;
- (p) "registered owner" includes the person or persons identified in the most recent municipal assessment roll as the owner of the subject property;
- (q) "Services" means, facilities, performances, exhibitions, viewings and encounters designed to appeal to erotic or sexual appetites or inclinations;
- (r) "sexual contact" means the kissing, fondling or sucking of breasts or genitalia, digital penetration, fellatio, cunnilingus, masturbation, ejaculation or intercourse;
- (s) "sign" includes any sign as defined pursuant to the Town of Ajax Sign By-law, as amended;
- (t) "Town" means The Corporation of the Town of Ajax.

### **3. General**

- 3.1 No person shall be an owner of an adult entertainment establishment without making application for, obtaining and maintaining, pursuant to the terms of this By-law, an adult entertainment establishment owner's licence and such licence has not expired, been revoked or suspended.
- 3.2 No person shall be an operator of an adult entertainment establishment without making application for, obtaining and maintaining, pursuant to the terms of this By-law, an adult entertainment operator's licence and such licence has not expired, been revoked or suspended.
- 3.3 No person shall be an attendant without making application for, obtaining and maintaining, pursuant to the terms of this By-law, an adult entertainment establishment attendant's licence and such licence has not expired, been revoked or suspended.
- 3.4 No owner, operator or attendant shall cause, permit, or allow the adult entertainment establishment to be open for business at any time between the hours of 2:00 o'clock in the morning on any day and 11:00 o'clock in the morning the same day.
- 3.5 The Licensing Officer may impose any conditions deemed appropriate to a licence to increase public safety or to minimize public nuisances including, but

not limited to:

- (a) The owner reimbursing the Town for any costs incurred by the Town for retaining Police Officers and any equipment, including vehicles, for the purposes of increasing public safety and preventing public nuisances from occurring on public property adjacent to the adult entertainment establishment, that may result or do result from the operation of the adult entertainment establishment. Where such costs have been determined prior to any event being held in the adult entertainment establishment such costs shall be paid to the Town three days prior to the date of the event;
- (b) Requiring every owner or operator having private security at a ratio designated by the Town while the adult entertainment establishment is open, wearing identification and clothing by which the private security can readily be identified as security guards;
- (c) Requiring a security deposit of not less than \$1,000.00 for repairs and clean up to both the owner's property and adjacent property;
- (d) Requiring a detailed parking analysis to ensure that the location can accommodate the event and other regular uses;
- (e) Implementing a crowd control plan which would include a description of the manner in which people seeking entry or re-entry into the adult entertainment establishment may line up outside of the adult entertainment establishment prior to entry. This plan would include the location of such line ups, the maximum number of people permitted to be in such line ups, the procedures used by the adult entertainment establishment to monitor the line ups, how to control the number of people in the line ups, how to ensure orderly conduct by the people in the line ups, and how to ensure that the line ups do not restrict or interfere with the use of public property;
- (f) Implementing a noise control plan that may include:
  - (i) The maximum volume levels for music within the adult entertainment establishment as approved by the Licensing Officer;
  - (ii) A complete description of all music or sound producing equipment being used in the adult entertainment establishment including the wattage of the equipment and number of speakers, etc.; and
  - (iii) The sound insulation methods or mechanisms used within the adult entertainment establishment or within the building in which the adult entertainment established is located.

#### **4. Owner/Operator Responsibilities**

- 4.1 No owner or operator shall cause, permit or allow any person who is under the age of eighteen (18) years of age to be an attendant.
- 4.2 No owner or operator shall cause, permit or allow any person under the age of eighteen (18) years of age to enter or remain in the adult entertainment establishment, when Services are provided.
- 4.3 No owner or operator shall permit or allow any person, other than a duly licenced attendant, to be nude or partially nude. For the purpose of this section a person is deemed to be nude or partially nude unless they are fully clothed.
- 4.4 No owner or operator shall permit an adult entertainment establishment to be open for business unless the owner or operator is in attendance, in person, on the premises.
- 4.5 No person shall own or operate an adult entertainment establishment except in compliance with the requirements of any conditions imposed upon the

licence.

- 4.6 No person shall own or operate an adult entertainment establishment except in compliance with the provisions of this By-law respecting "Location Restrictions and Limitation on Number".
- 4.7 No person shall own or operate an adult entertainment establishment except in compliance with the provisions of this By-law respecting "Design of Premises".
- 4.8 No person shall advertise or promote an adult entertainment establishment except in accordance with the provisions of this By-law respecting "Signs and Advertisements".
- 4.9 No person shall own or operate an adult entertainment establishment except in compliance with the provisions of this By-law respecting "Conduct of Services Provided".
- 4.10 No owner or operator shall knowingly, or not knowingly, permit or allow, any attendant to provide Services at an adult entertainment establishment unless such attendant is licenced pursuant to the provisions of this By-law and such licence has not expired, been revoked or suspended.
- 4.11 Every owner and operator shall ensure that no Services are provided, other than in accordance with the requirements of this By-law.
- 4.12 No Person shall be an operator of an adult entertainment establishment unless the owner of the establishment holds an adult entertainment establishment owner's licence which has not expired, been revoked, or suspended.
- 4.13 Every adult entertainment establishment shall comply with all Provincial and Municipal Legislation, as amended, including, but not limited to; The Fire Protection and Prevention Act, S.O 1997, The Ontario Building Code, The Town of Ajax Fortification By-law, etc.

## **5. Attendant's Responsibilities**

- 5.1 No attendant shall provide Services unless there is a licenced adult entertainment establishment owner or operator in attendance, and the licence has not expired, been revoked, or suspended.
- 5.2 No person shall provide Services in an adult entertainment establishment unless the owner of the establishment holds an adult entertainment establishment owner's licence, which has not expired, been revoked or suspended.

## **6. Location Restrictions and Limitation on Number**

- 6.1 No person may own or operate an adult entertainment establishment from any premises except upon such lands as stated in Schedule "A".
- 6.2 No person shall own or operate an adult entertainment establishment except in compliance with the Town's Zoning By-law, as amended.
- 6.3 No person shall own or operate an adult entertainment establishment on property located within 500 m of property containing another adult entertainment establishment.

## **7. Design of Premises**

- 7.1 No person may be an owner or operator of an adult entertainment establishment except in accordance with the following regulations;
  - (a) Each owner and operator shall ensure that there is posted in a prominent location, on the exterior of the building, near the entrance to the adult entertainment establishment, a sign indicating that no person under the age

of eighteen (18) years of age may enter or remain in the premises, when Services are provided;

- (b) Each owner and operator shall ensure that there is posted in a prominent location, on the interior of the building, near the entrance to the adult entertainment establishment, a sign stating all the Services offered in the establishment;
- (c) Every owner and operator shall post their respective licence in a conspicuous place, on the interior of the building, near the main entrance of the adult entertainment establishment;
- (d) The owner shall provide the Licensing Officer with a drawing of the floor plan of the premises, together with a description including what part of the premises are to be utilized for what purpose. This drawing shall include details of any stage door, walls, seating areas and partitions and main stage. In the event that the owner or operator wishes to amend the floor plan, he/she shall first file with the Licensing Officer a copy of the amended floor plan and shall not proceed to make such alterations without first obtaining the approval of the Licensing Officer;
- (e) All Services provided by an attendant shall be clearly visible, without obstruction by anything, including but not limited to walls, curtains, fog, inadequate lighting, etc;
- (f) Every owner and operator shall ensure that no public address system, sound equipment, loudspeaker or similar device is used outside of the adult entertainment establishment;
- (g) The adult entertainment establishment shall be provided with adequate ventilation and lighting that is adequate to ensure visibility;
- (h) No door to any room or area, save and except for the designated office space, one storage room, any rooms required for mechanical systems, and washroom cubicles, shall be equipped with a locking device of any kind;
- (i) No premises or part thereof used as an adult entertainment establishment shall be used as a dwelling or for sleeping purposes or contain therein any furniture which is commonly used or which may be used for sleeping purposes;
- (j) During the hours of business the owner or operator shall ensure that the door or doors used as the principal access to the establishment by the public are kept unlocked so that anyone may enter or exit without hindrance or delay.

## **8. Signs and Advertisements**

8.1 No person may erect or maintain, or permit to be erected or maintained, any sign, except in accordance with Town By-laws, including the Town Sign By-law (as amended). Notwithstanding the provisions of the Town Sign By-law (as amended), no person may erect or maintain or permit any sign advertising an adult entertainment establishment except in accordance with the following additional regulations:

- (a) No person may erect, maintain or permit to be erected, any of the following Signs in respect of an adult entertainment establishment;
  - A-Frame Sign                      - Directional Sign                      - Portable Sign
  - Poster Sign
- (b) No Person may circulate, post, distribute or cause to be circulated, posted, or distributed any poster, flyer, handbill or other form of printed sign on

premises or locations other than the adult entertainment establishment;

- (c) Nothing within this By-law shall be deemed to constrain any person from erecting or maintaining any sign or advertising on any interior wall of an adult entertainment establishment, provided the content of such sign is not visible from the exterior of the establishment:
- (d) No person may erect or maintain any sign or advertising in respect of an adult entertainment establishment which includes any letters, markings, symbols, pictures or representations except the name of the adult entertainment establishment, as recorded on the application for licence and any registered copyright logo or symbol, provided a copy of such logo or symbol is approved by the Licensing Officer as part of the licensing process;

## **9. Conduct of Services Provided**

- 9.1 It shall constitute an offence for an owner or operator, to cause, permit, or allow, knowingly or unknowingly, within the adult entertainment establishment;
  - (a) any attendant, to touch or be touched by, or to have physical contact with, any other person, in any manner whatsoever, involving part of that person's body, whether or not the touching is skin to skin, unless both parties are fully clothed.
  - (b) any owner, operator, or person to have sexual contact with another person.

## **10. Nature of Licence**

- 10.1 No person shall enjoy a vested right in the continuance of a licence and the value of a licence shall be the property of the Town and shall remain so irrespective of the issue, renewal or revocation thereof.
- 10.2 The licences required by this By-law shall, unless they are expressed to be for a shorter or longer time, be for the period up to and including the 31st day of December in the year of issuance, unless they are sooner forfeited or revoked.
- 10.3 No licence shall be transferred or assigned and if an owner, operator or attendant sells, leases or otherwise disposes of his/her interest in the trade, calling business or occupation carried on at an adult entertainment establishment, their licence in respect of such establishment or activity shall, notwithstanding any other provision of this By-law, be revoked.
- 10.4 Every licence shall have endorsed thereon the location of an adult entertainment establishment and such endorsement shall be for one location only and such licence shall be valid only for the location endorsed thereon.
- 10.5 A duplicate licence may be issued by the Licensing Officer to replace any licence previously issued which has been lost, stolen or destroyed, upon written application by the licensee and payment of the fee as stated in Schedule "B" of this by-law. The licensee will provide the Licensing Officer with 2 passport size photographs with the replacement Licence application.
- 10.6 Any licence that has not been renewed as of December 31st in the year of its issuance or renewal shall expire on January 1st in the year following its issuance or renewal.

## **11. Application Procedure**

- 11.1 Every applicant shall appear in person before a Licensing Officer and shall complete such licence application forms as may be provided from time to time by the Licensing Officer in accordance with the requirements of this By-law and shall provide all information requested thereon, such information to include

- (a) Canadian Police Clearance Letter dated within thirty (30) days of the date of the application; and
- (b) valid photo identification, satisfactory to the Licensing Officer.

In the case of an adult entertainment establishment owned by a partnership such appearance shall be made by one of the partners, provided the application shall be signed by all of the partners, and in the case of an adult entertainment establishment owned by a corporation, such appearance shall be made by an officer of the corporation and not by an agent thereof.

11.2 Every applicant for an attendant's and operator's licence shall provide two (2) passport size photographs, which must be taken no more than thirty (30) days prior to submission of the licence application.

11.3 Every applicant for an;

- (a) operator's licence shall provide the Licensing Officer with a written contract of employment between the owner of the adult entertainment establishment and the applicant and signed by the licenced owner of the establishment named in the application.
- (b) attendant's licence shall provide the licensing Officer with a written contract of employment between the owner, or the operator of the adult entertainment establishment and the applicant and signed by the licenced owner, or operator of the establishment named in the application.

The contract of employment shall be dated within 30 days of the date of the application.

11.4 At the time of submission of their application, every applicant shall pay to the Town the fee set forth in Schedule "B" and such fee shall not be reduced in the event that the period for which the licence is granted is less than one year

11.5 Every person applying for an adult entertainment establishment owner's licence shall file with the Licensing Officer documentation satisfactory to the Licensing Officer demonstrating the applicant's right to possess or occupy the premises and if any applicant is not the registered owner of the property upon which the adult entertainment establishment is to be located, such person shall file with the Licensing Officer a copy of their lease, if any, and a copy of any other document constituting or affecting the legal relationship relating to the said lands or premises between said applicant and the registered owner.

11.6 Without limiting the generality of any other provision in this By-law, persons associated in a partnership applying for a licence under this By-law shall file with their application a statutory declaration, in writing, signed by all members of the partnership, which declaration shall state:

- (a) the full name of every partner and the address of his/her ordinary residence;
- (b) the name or names under which they carry on or intend to carry on business;
- (c) that the persons therein named are the only members of the partnership; and
- (d) the mailing address for the partnership.

11.7 If any member of a partnership applying for a licence is a corporation, such corporation shall be deemed to be applying for an owner's licence as appropriate in place and stead of the partnership.

11.8 Without limiting the generality of any other provision in this By-law, every corporation applying for a licence shall file with the Licensing Officer, at the time of making its application, a copy of its articles of incorporation or other incorporating documents and shall file a statutory declaration, in writing, signed by an officer of the corporation, which declaration shall state:

- (a) the full name of every shareholder and the address of his/her ordinary residence;
- (b) the name or names under which it carries on or intends to carry on business;
- (c) that the persons therein named are the only shareholders of the corporation; and
- (d) the mailing address for the corporation.

11.9 Receipt of the application and/or the licence fee by the Town shall not represent approval of the application for the issuance of a licence nor shall it obligate the Town to issue such licence.

11.10 The Licensing Officer shall:

- (a) receive and process all applications for licences and renewal of licences to be issued under this By-law;
- (b) co-ordinate the enforcement of this By-law;
- (c) generally perform all the administrative functions conferred upon him/her by this By-law;
- (d) make or cause to be made a circulation respecting each application, which shall include circulation of the Licence application to the Medical Officer of Health and Municipal and Provincial Police Departments for comments;
- (e) make or cause to be made all investigations and inspections which he/she deems necessary to determine whether an applicant meets the requirements of this By-law and all applicable laws;
- (f) issue licences to persons who meet the requirements of this By-law and suspend Licences pursuant to the requirements of this By-law;
- (g) where a licence has been issued pursuant to this By-law and otherwise remains in full force and effect, renew the licences of persons who meet the requirements of this By-law;

## **12. Issuance, Suspension, Revocation of Licence**

### Issuance

12.1 The Licensing Officer shall issue the licence only where,

- (a) all the information which the applicant is required to provide under this By-law has been provided, and verified;
- (b) all the documents which the applicant is required to provide under this by-law have been provided;
- (c) the licence fee is paid;
- (d) the investigations do not disclose that the issuing of such licence may be adverse to the public interest;
- (e) the Licensing Officer has no grounds to believe the applicant will not conduct himself/herself in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity.

12.2 Where the Licensing Officer determines that a licence should not be issued as a result of any matter in Section 12.1 of this By-law he/she shall notify the applicant.

12.3 Where an applicant advises the Licensing Officer in writing, within 30 days, that he/she disputes the determination made by the Licensing Officer under

Section 12.2 of this By-law or submits that the licence applied for should be issued despite that determination, the matter shall be referred forthwith by the Licensing Officer to the Committee which shall hear the representations from the applicant.

12.4 The Committee may authorize the Licensing Officer to issue the Licence where it determines that the determination in Section 12.2 of this By-law is not sufficient to justify refusing to issue the licence.

12.5 The Licensing Officer shall advise the applicant of the Committee's determination.

#### Suspension/Revocation

12.6 The Licensing Officer shall notify a licensee, that the licence shall be suspended or revoked, when,

- (a) the Licensing Officer has cause to believe, on reasonable grounds, that the licensee will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity;
- (b) the licensee has been convicted of an offence which is a contravention of this By-law;
- (c) the Licensing Officer has cause to believe that the licensee has failed to engage in business in accordance with the conditions imposed upon the licence.

12.7 Where a licensee advises the Licensing Officer, in writing and within thirty days that he/she disputes the suspension or revocation of the licence, the matter shall be referred forthwith, to the Committee, which shall hear representations from the licensee and either confirm the suspension or revocation of the licence or reinstate it as it sees fit.

12.8 The Licensing Officer shall advise the applicant of the Committee's determination.

12.9 Where the licensee does not dispute the suspension or revocation of the licence, within 30 days of the notification referred to in Section 12.6, the Licensing Officer shall forthwith suspend or revoke the Licence.

#### Suspension Without Hearing

12.10 The Licensing Officer may suspend the licence of any adult entertainment establishment for a period not to exceed 14 days, without a hearing, providing the Licensing Officer;

- (a) is satisfied that the continuation of the business poses an immediate danger to the health or safety of any person or property; and
- (b) has notified the licensee, either orally or in writing, prior to the suspension of the licence, with the reasons for the suspension and provided the licensee with an opportunity to respond.

12.11 When a licence has been suspended in accordance with Section 12.11, the matter shall be referred forthwith, by the licensing Officer, to the Committee, which shall hear representations from the licensee.

12.12 The Committee may;

- (a) reinstate the licence, with or without special conditions;
- (b) suspend the licence for a specified period of time; and may impose conditions upon the licence;
- (c) revoke the licence

### **13. Change of Status**

- 13.1 Where there is any change in any of the particulars relating to a person licenced under this By-law, which particulars are required to be filed with the Town on applying for a licence under this By-law, such person shall report the change, in writing, to the Licensing Officer within seven (7) days of the change.
- 13.2 Where there is to be a change in the composition or the controlling interest of a partnership licenced under this By-law, the persons licenced hereunder in partnership shall obtain the approval of the Licensing Officer to such change prior thereto. Where there has been any change in the controlling interest of the partnership by virtue of a number of transactions, the licence may be suspended despite the Licensing Officer's prior approval of any one or more such transactions.
- 13.3 Where there is to be a change in the composition or the controlling interest of the shareholders of a corporation licenced under this By-law, the corporation shall obtain the approval of the Licensing Officer to such change prior. Where there has been any change in the controlling interest of the corporation by virtue of a number of transactions, the licence may be suspended, despite the Licensing Officer's prior approval of any one or more such transactions.

### **14. Offence, Penalty and Enforcement**

- 14.1 Any person who contravenes the provisions of this By-law, including every person who fails to perform a duty imposed herein or who performs an act prohibited herein is guilty of an offence and, upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty for each offence, exclusive of costs, as prescribed by the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O 2001, as amended.
- 14.2 The making of a false or intentionally misleading recital of fact, statement or representation in any agreement, statutory declaration or application form required by this By-law shall be deemed to be a violation of the provisions of this By-law.
- 14.3 Every person shall comply with the provisions of this By-law applicable to him/her whether or not he/she is licenced under this By-law.
- 14.4 Every owner, operator and attendant shall, during the operating hours of the adult entertainment establishment and at all times when Services are provided therein, make available for inspection by the Licensing Officer, a Police Officer, a Medical Officer of Health, a Provincial Offences Officer, or a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer the original of any document or record referred to in this By-law.
- 14.5 Every owner and every operator of an adult entertainment establishment shall, at all times during the hours of operation of the adult entertainment establishment and during all hours when Services are being provided at the establishment, permit the entry by and the inspection of the establishment by a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, a Provincial Offences Officer, the Licensing Officer, a Medical Officer of Health or a Police Officer.
- 14.6 No person may obstruct or hinder the entry or the inspection of an adult entertainment establishment by a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, a Provincial Offences Officer, the Licensing Officer, a Medical Officer of Health or a Police Officer.

### **15. Validity**

- 15.1 The provisions of this By-law shall apply to all lands and premises within the Town.
- 15.2 Should any section of this By-law be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such section shall be construed as being severed herefrom and

the remainder of the By-law shall continue in full force and effect.

15.3 All schedules referred to in this By-law are deemed to be part of this By-law.

15.4 Wherever notice or materials are required to be provided to any person pursuant to this Bylaw, such notice shall be deemed effective two (2) days after mailing of the materials by registered mail to the last address of that person as indicated upon the licence application or upon other material filed with the Town or to the last assessed business address for the person, or as indicated upon the Taxation Roll Records.

**16. Repeal**

16.1 By-law 72-90, "Adult Entertainment Parlours" and By-law shall be repealed.

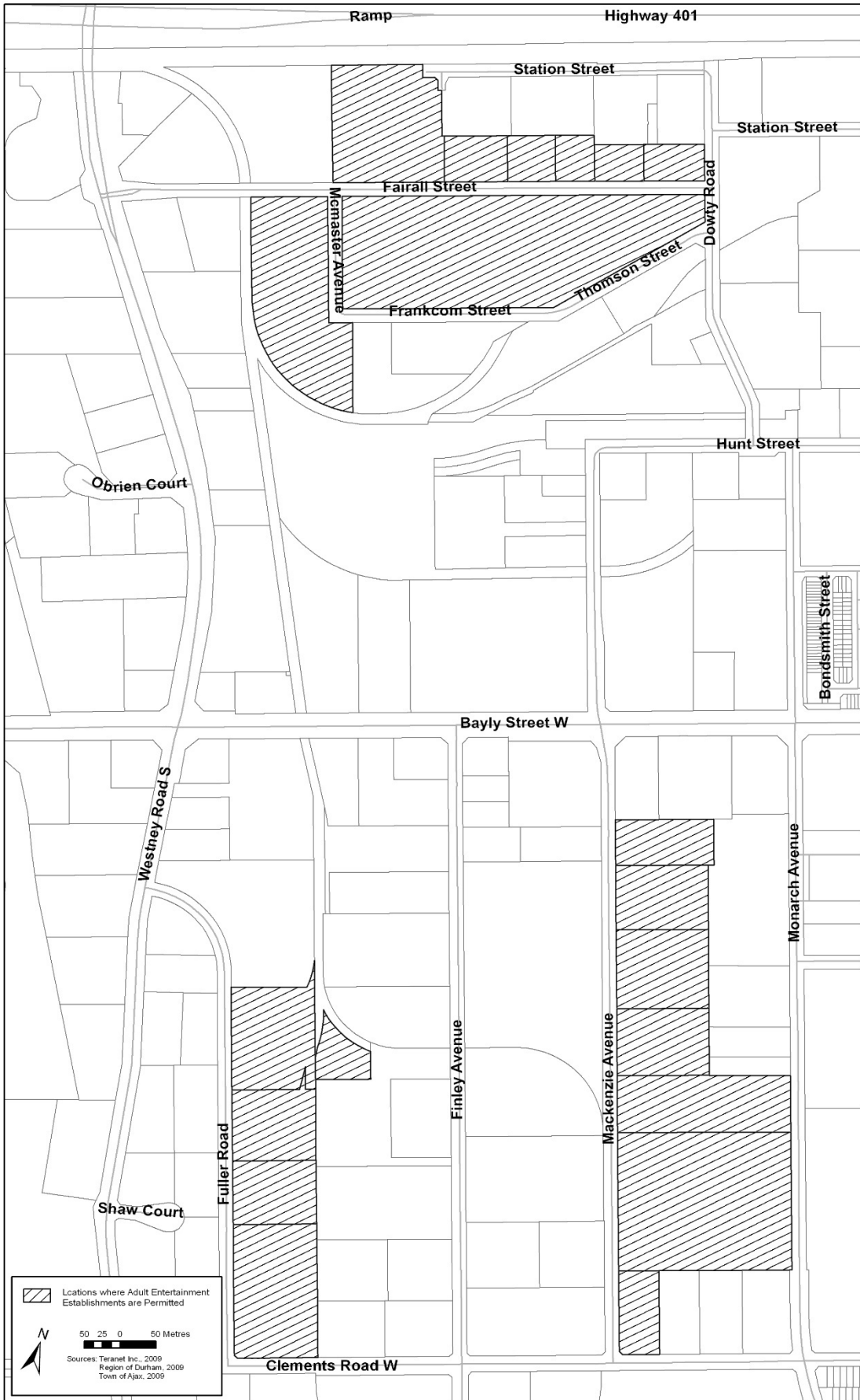
