Whereas, the intersection of Searell Avenue and Selby Drive is adjacent to Meadows Park and Vimy Ridge Public School;

Whereas, children and families on the west side of Searell must either jay-walk or walk to the intersection of Searell Avenue and Telford Street to cross at a stop sign;

Whereas, there is a 3-Way Stop sign on the east side of Meadows Park and Vimy Ridge Public School at Bellinger Drive and Taverner Crescent;

Whereas, the community could be well served by the addition of a 3-way stop installation, allowing families to safely cross Searell Avenue to access the park and school;

Therefore, be it resolved:

1. That Ajax Council approves the installation of a 3-Way Stop at the intersection of Searell Ave. & Selby Dr. by the end of October 2025.
2. That the cost to install the stop signs be managed within the 2025 Operations and Environmental Services budget in accordance with the Operating Budget Management Policy.

9.4 3-Way Stop Installation at Williamson Drive West & Seggar Avenue

Whereas, a crossing upgrade has been recommended for the intersection of Williamson Drive West and Seggar Avenue in the 2026 Capital Budget, including a higher-order pedestrian crossover (PXO);

Whereas, community members and organizations, including families, Road Watch, and the administration of Nottingham Public School, have shared that they feel they would be better served by a 3-way stop installation;

Whereas, stop signs are cheaper, require less maintenance, and ensure drivers come to a complete stop;

Therefore be it resolved:

1. That Ajax Council approves the installation of a 3-Way Stop at the intersection of Williamson Dr. W. and Seggar Ave. by the end of October 2025.
2. That the cost to install the stop signs be managed within the 2025 Operations and Environmental Services budget in accordance with the Operating Budget Management Policy.
